



Guidelines for participation of Children in Theater III

For the purposes of these guidelines, a child shall be defined as someone less than 16 years of age.

Children shall receive age appropriate supervision at all times.

Supervision shall be provided by either one or more parents of the child(ren).

Parents of children in the show must agree, on the audition form, as a condition of their child's being cast in a show, to be available for participation in the above process.

Children shall not be allowed to crew back stage.

Children will be encouraged, whenever possible, to change into costume before coming to the theater.

The cast, production staff, and parents will be asked not to use inappropriate language in the presence of children.

The cast and production crew shall avoid all physical contact with children unless required as part of their normal theater duties.

Children shall never leave the theater unless accompanied by their parent or by a person officially designated, in writing, by their parents to take that responsibility.

The cast and production crew shall use reasonable efforts to avoid being alone with the children.
